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#### PRELIMINARY SCOPE OF WORK

#### PROJECT NAME: Leeds WWTP UV Design and Construction Management

#### Background and Site Information:

The Leeds WWTP (NPDES Permit No. AL0067067) is located at 800 Helen Street Leeds, AL 35094. The WWTP is permitted for 2.0MGD. The annual average daily flow varies between 0.9 and 1.29 MGD, and peak daily flows approach 6 MG. The WWTP was newly constructed and placed into operation in 1995, and there have been no significant process or equipment changes since. The existing UV system is a Trojan 3000 with six 1.67 MGD banks. The summer E. Coli monthly average limit is 126 col/100ml. Recent effluent UVT measurements average 90%.

#### Project Description:

Engineering designs for the replacement of the existing UV system with a new effective and efficient system that will meet the needs of the facility over the expected life of the equipment.

#### Consultant's Scope of Work:

The general scope of work will include detailed engineering designs and plans for the construction of the recommended improvements, bidding services including UV pre-selection bid, and construction observation and management. The detailed design scope of work will include a master planning study to determine flow projections and other critical inputs into the design; a review of the electrical system and previous studies; evaluating whether standby power is adequate; an updated arc flash analysis after the construction work is complete; a design for the conversion of the plant's existing ScadaVision HMI software to Citect; a design for replacement of the plant's existing RTU hardware with PLCs; and design of other instrumentation and control upgrades as desired by the County and recommended by the Consultant.
